



Admission exam 2023-2024 in Operative & Esthetic Dentistry
Department of Restorative Sciences
Faculty of Dentistry, Beirut Arab University

Components of the test:

1- Written exam:

- Covers areas related to diseases of hard tooth structure; diagnosis, and treatment planning, properties of restorative materials; application techniques.
- Test format include MCQ and case study.
- Time allowed is 1 hour.

2- Practical exam:

- Includes Class II preparation, Composite restoration, and finishing.
- The practical exam will be performed in the phantom lab on Typodont teeth. Total time allowed is 1 hour.
- Instruments and materials: applicants should get their own diagnostic and operative kits to perform cavity preparation, composite restoration, finishing and polishing.
- Casts will be provided in the lab.
- Infection control measures is applied in simulation lab
- **Check list:**
 1. Hand and rotary instruments and hand piece; mirror, probe, tweezers, composite application kits, separation matrix, cutting and finishing burs discs and strips.
 2. Bonding agents and resin composite material
 3. Napkins, masks and gloves, lab coat.
 4. Teeth assigned for the exam will be available in the lab to purchase just before the exam started.
 5. Light cure units.

3- Oral exam:

Will be based upon, but not limited to, discussion of clinical cases of restorative treatment.
